***Please DO NOT BRING any of the following items:**

Candy, gum snacks, drinks, etc- kamp furnishes 3 great meals as well as some snacks
Paisley bandanas – These can be seen as gang related.
Pornographic materials such as books, magazines, DVDs, video, etc.
Items of high monetary or sentimental value as these could be lost, damaged or stolen
Demonic, satanic, witchcraft, occults, new age books, or any other materials associated with such, music with parental advisory labels, Journals, writings, etc. with explicit or occult material
Any type of magazine or reading materials other than what is listed as items to bring
Weapons (guns, shanks, razor blades, etc.)
Radios, iPods, MP3 Players, cell phone, other such devices
Any jewelry other what is listed in the items to bring list
Perfume, scented lotions – these attract bugs
Ω Alcohol, drugs or tobacco products

*Any and all of these items will be confiscated and kept for you in our office until the end of your session, but please understand we are not responsible for loss or theft of these items.

Ω Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, and illegal drugs are prohibited and will cause **dismissal from kamp!**
These items will not be returned to kampers.

To help insure kamper, staff and Kaleo safety; no assumption of privacy should be made regarding any luggage, bags or belongings kept on kamp property.

T-shirts, caps and Christian music are available for purchase in the kamp store.

Use of Phone

In the case of any emergency, parents or the person listed as an emergency contact on the kamper form will be notified immediately. We do not allow phone calls to kampers, incoming or outgoing due to scheduling and capacity conflicts. This includes Father's Day, birthdays, other holidays, and special occasions.
